AN ACT CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF A NEW PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A DOCK WHEN THE FORMER PERMIT HAS EXPIRED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to issue a new permit for the construction of a dock within sixty days to a resident who was not able to construct such dock under a formerly issued permit that has since expired, provided there are no changes in the application from the formerly approved permit.

Statement of Purpose:

To expedite the issuance of a new permit to build a dock when the former permit has expired but there are no changes to the application for such permit.
