AN ACT REQUIRING LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION'S EVICTION OF FARMERS CONDUCTING FARMING ON STATE-OWNED PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective from passage) Notwithstanding any 2 provision of the general statutes, any lease renewed or entered into after 3 the effective date of this section between the Commissioner of 4 Agriculture or the Commissioner of Energy and Environmental 5 Protection and a farmer for the lease of state property for agricultural 6 purposes shall provide that any eviction of such farmer from such 7 property shall not be permitted unless such eviction is approved by a 8 vote of both chambers of the General Assembly.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	from passage	New section

To protect farmers who permissibly farm on state-owned land.
