AN ACT REQUIRING THE EXPEDITING OF PERMITS FOR THE REMEDIATION OF HYDRILLA IN LAKES ACROSS THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (6) of section 22-79a of the general statutes, if the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection fails to take action on a permit for the remediation of hydrilla in a lake not later than three months after receipt of such permit application by said department, such application shall be deemed approved.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
