AN ACT CONCERNING THE BURNING OF MEDICAL WASTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) No person shall operate a medical waste incinerator unless such incinerator is in compliance with all standards of the United States Environmental Protection Agency for medical waste incinerators. The Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection may adopt regulations, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, to provide for the enforcement of the provisions of this section.
