AN ACT CONCERNING NOTICE TO ABUTTING LAND OWNERS AND THE DISCLOSURE OF SUBSIDIARY PROFIT AND LOSS STATEMENTS IN PUBLIC UTILITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY RATE CASES AND CREATING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE CREATION OF MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require that (1) the 2 Connecticut Siting Council adopt rules concerning notice to any owner 3 of property that abuts the site of a development subject to said council's 4 review that are consistent with rules adopted by the Public Utilities 5 Regulatory Authority concerning notice to any owner of property that 6 abuts the site of a development subject to said authority's review, (2) any 7 entity subject to a rate case before the Public Utilities Regulatory 8 Authority disclose profit and loss statements for any subsidiary of such 9 entity that operates in the state, and (3) that a task force be established 10 to study allowing a municipality to create municipal electric companies 11 for the purpose of providing electricity to the residents of such 12 municipality.

Statement of Purpose:

To (1) require consistency in notice to abutting land owners in matters before the Connecticut Siting Council and Public Utilities Regulatory Authority, (2) require the disclosure of profit and loss statements of any subsidiary of an entity subject to a rate case before the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority, and (3) to create a task force to study the creation of municipal electric companies.
