AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF REPURPOSING OR SELLING UNDERUTILIZED STATE-OWNED BUILDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the Commissioner of Administrative Services be required to (1) 2 conduct a study concerning the feasibility, benefits and disadvantages 3 to repurposing or selling underutilized state-owned buildings, 4 including any potential benefits or disadvantages for the municipality 5 in which the buildings are located, and (2) submit a report on the findings of such study to the joint standing committee of the General 6 7 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the leasing, purchase 8 and sale, transfer or the disposition of state property and facilities, not 9 later than December 31, 2025.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Administrative Services to conduct a study concerning the repurposing or selling of underutilized stateowned buildings and to submit a report concerning the findings of such study.
