**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF REPURPOSING OR SELLING
UNDERUTILIZED STATE-OWNED BUILDINGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Commissioner of Administrative Services be required to (1)
- 2 conduct a study concerning the feasibility, benefits and disadvantages
- 3 to repurposing or selling underutilized state-owned buildings,
- 4 including any potential benefits or disadvantages for the municipality
- 5 in which the buildings are located, and (2) submit a report on the
- 6 findings of such study to the joint standing committee of the General
- 7 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the leasing, purchase
- 8 and sale, transfer or the disposition of state property and facilities, not
- 9 later than December 31, 2025.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Administrative Services to conduct a study concerning the repurposing or selling of underutilized state-owned buildings and to submit a report concerning the findings of such study.
