AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF REPURPOSING OR SELLING UNDERUTILIZED STATE-OWNED BUILDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Administrative 2 Services shall (1) conduct a study concerning the feasibility, benefits and 3 disadvantages to repurposing or selling underutilized state-owned buildings, including any potential benefits or disadvantages for the 4 5 municipality in which the buildings are located, and (2) not later than 6 December 31, 2025, submit a report, in accordance with the provisions 7 of section 11-4a of the general statutes, on the findings of such study to 8 the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having 9 cognizance of matters relating to the leasing, purchase and sale, transfer 10 or the disposition of state property and facilities.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	from passage	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Commissioner of Administrative Services to conduct a study concerning the repurposing or selling of underutilized stateowned buildings and to submit a report concerning the findings of such study.
