AN ACT PROHIBITING THE MANUFACTURE, DISTRIBUTION, DELIVERY OR SALE OF FOODS CONTAINING CERTAIN ADDITIVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That chapter 417 of the general statutes be amended to provide that no person doing business in this state shall manufacture, distribute, deliver or sell any food if such food (1) is intended for human consumption, and (2) contains (A) brominated vegetable oil, (B) potassium bromate, (C) propylparaben, or (D) red dye number three.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the manufacture, distribution, delivery or sale of foods containing certain additives.
