**AN ACT CONCERNING DRUGS PRESCRIBED TO TREAT
ATTENTION-DEFICIT/HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 400j of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 a pharmacist shall dispense a drug prescribed to treat attention-
- 3 deficit/hyperactivity disorder if the patient (1) has a valid prescription
- 4 for such drug, and (2) provides to the pharmacist a quantitative
- 5 electroencephalogram brain map produced for the patient.

Statement of Purpose:

To further specify the circumstances in which a pharmacist shall dispense a drug prescribed to treat attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder.
