## AN ACT CONCERNING DRUGS PRESCRIBED TO TREAT ATTENTION-DEFICIT/HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 400j of the general statutes be amended to provide that

2 a pharmacist shall dispense a drug prescribed to treat attention-

3 deficit/hyperactivity disorder if the patient (1) has a valid prescription

4 for such drug, and (2) provides to the pharmacist a quantitative

5 electroencephalogram brain map produced for the patient.

## Statement of Purpose:

To further specify the circumstances in which a pharmacist shall dispense a drug prescribed to treat attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder.
