**AN ACT REQUIRING CONSUMERS' CONSENT TO STORE CREDIT
CARD OR OTHER PAYMENT INFORMATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that any person
- 2 doing business in this state shall obtain written consent from a consumer
- 3 before storing the consumer's credit card or other payment information.

Statement of Purpose:

To require any person doing business in this state to obtain written
consent from a consumer before storing the consumer's credit card or
other payment information.
