**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF  
ESTABLISHING AN ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES INTAKE UNIT  
WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGING AND DISABILITY SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Aging and Disability Services to (1) conduct a study
- 3 concerning the feasibility of establishing an adult protective services
- 4 intake unit similar to that of New York City's Department of Social
- 5 Services, and (2) report the findings of such study not later than
- 6 December 31, 2025, to the joint standing committee of the General
- 7 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to human services.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To support senior citizens vulnerable to the risk of fraud and abuse.
