## AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING AN ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES INTAKE UNIT WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGING AND DISABILITY SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 17a of the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner of Aging and Disability Services to (1) conduct a study concerning the feasibility of establishing an adult protective services intake unit similar to that of New York City's Department of Social Services, and (2) report the findings of such study not later than December 31, 2025, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to human services.

To support senior citizens vulnerable to the risk of fraud and abuse.
