AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPANSION OF AGING IN PLACE PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to require the 2 Department of Social Services to expand, within available 3 appropriations, programs allowing senior citizens to age in place in 4 their homes or communities.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand opportunities for senior citizens to remain independently in their homes and communities and avoid costs to the state and senior citizens for institutionalization.
