## AN ACT AUTHORIZING A MEDICAID WAIVER TO REQUIRE CERTAIN ADULT MEDICAID RECIPIENTS TO WORK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to authorize the 2 Commissioner of Social Services to seek a federal Medicaid waiver that 3 would require certain Medicaid beneficiaries between the ages of 4 twenty and thirty to work twenty hours weekly without fear of losing 5 Medicaid benefits.

## Statement of Purpose:

To reduce barriers to employment for young adult Medicaid beneficiaries who are able to obtain work but fear losing benefits.
