***AN ACT PROVIDING IMMUNITY FROM CIVIL LIABILITY TO A
PHYSICIAN WHO ACCOMPANIES AND ASSISTS A STATE,
REGIONAL OR MUNICIPAL SWAT TEAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 925 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 any person licensed to practice medicine and surgery under the
- 3 provisions of chapter 370 of the general statutes, who, voluntarily and
- 4 gratuitously and other than in the course of such person's employment
- 5 or practice, renders emergency medical assistance in connection with
- 6 the law enforcement duties of a state, regional or municipal special
- 7 weapons and tactics team, shall not be liable to any person assisted for
- 8 civil damages for any personal injuries that result from acts or omissions
- 9 by such licensed person in rendering emergency medical assistance,
- 10 which may constitute ordinary negligence.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide immunity to a physician who accompanies and assists a state, regional or municipal SWAT team.
