**AN ACT INCENTIVIZING EDUCATIONAL AND WORKFORCE  
ACHIEVEMENT AS A MEANS OF REDUCING A PROBATIONER'S  
TERM OF SUPERVISION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 961 of the general statutes be amended to permit Adult
- 2 Probation Services, without leave of the court, to incentivize educational
- 3 and employment achievement by awarding a compliant probationer
- 4 with (1) a sixty-day reduction of such probationer's term of supervision
- 5 for each educational advancement activity completed by the
- 6 probationer during a term of probation, and (2) a thirty-day reduction
- 7 of such probationer's term of supervision for each workforce activity
- 8 completed by the probationer during a term of probation.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To incentivize educational and workforce achievement as a means of reducing a probationer's term of supervision.
