**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONSIDERATION OF PUBLIC SAFETY
WHEN DETERMINING WHETHER TO TRANSFER A JUVENILE TO
ADULT COURT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subparagraph (C) of subdivision (3) of subsection (a) of section
- 2 46b-127 of the general statutes and subdivision (3) of subsection (b) of
- 3 section 46b-127 of the general statutes be amended to read "after
- 4 weighing the best interests of the child, the best interests of the public
- 5 will not be served by maintaining the case in the superior court for
- 6 juvenile matters."

Statement of Purpose:

To place greater weight on the safety of the public when a court considers the transference of a juvenile to adult court.
