AN ACT CONCERNING PREVAILING WAGE FOR MUNICIPAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 31-53 of the general statutes be amended to allow 2 municipal construction projects to be exempt from the prevailing wage 3 requirements when the municipality can demonstrate, by a majority vote of the legislative body of that municipality, that adhering to the 4 5 prevailing wage requirements will cause an undue financial hardship, 6 including, but not limited to, instances where health and safety would 7 be jeopardized by a project not being completed due to a lack of sufficient funds to pay costs associated with prevailing wage 8 9 requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To create an exemption from the prevailing wage requirements for municipalities experiencing undue financial hardships.
