**AN ACT CONCERNING APPLICATIONS FOR APPRENTICESHIP
RATIO RELIEF.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 557 of the general statutes be amended to (1) require the
- 2 Labor Department to take action on an application for apprenticeship
- 3 ratio relief within ten business days of submittal, (2) deem any such
- 4 application approved if no action is taken by the Labor Department
- 5 within ten business days of submittal, and (3) require the Labor
- 6 Department to submit a quarterly report of denials of applications for
- 7 apprenticeship ratio relief to the joint standing committees of the
- 8 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor and
- 9 public employees and general law.

Statement of Purpose:

To expedite the application process for apprenticeship ratio relief and to require quarterly reports of denials of applications for apprenticeship ratio relief.
