## AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC BOOK LICENSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that any publisher 2 who offers to license electronic books to the public shall offer to license 3 such books to libraries in the state on reasonable terms, including, but 4 not limited to, (1) a limitation on the number of users to whom such 5 libraries may simultaneously provide access to an electronic book, (2) a 6 limitation on the number of days such libraries may provide users with 7 access to an electronic book, and (3) the use of technological protection 8 measures to prevent users from (A) maintaining access to electronic 9 books beyond the access period set forth in a license, and (B) providing 10 other users with access to electronic books. Such reasonable terms shall not include a limitation on the number of licenses for electronic books a 11 library may purchase and make available to the public. 12

## Statement of Purpose:

To require publishers of electronic books to license such books to public libraries on reasonable terms.
