AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MOBILE HEALTH CLINIC PROGRAM AT CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to (1) establish a mobile health clinic program that provides inmates at each correctional institution with specialty care on a monthly basis using mobile health clinics, and (2) require the Commissioner of Correction to report quarterly to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public health and the judiciary regarding the number of inmates treated by such mobile health clinics.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve health care of inmates.
