AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF REIMBURSING STUDENT LOAN PAYMENTS BY HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS WHO PROVIDE PRO BONO SERVICES AT SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CLINICS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Commissioner of Public Health be required to study, in
- 2 consultation with the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management,
- 3 the feasibility of establishing a student loan reimbursement program
- 4 that would benefit health care providers who provide pro bono services
- 5 at one or more school-based health clinics for a certain number of hours
- 6 annually.

Statement of Purpose:

To require a study of the feasibility of establishing a student loan reimbursement program for health care providers who provide pro bono services at school-based health clinics.
