AN ACT CONCERNING THE SPENDING CAP.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 2-33a of the general statutes be amended to redefine the
- 2 state "spending cap" to limit the growth of all state expenditures,
- 3 including off-budget items, by (1) eliminating an increase in inflation as
- 4 a factor that would allow for an increase in general budget expenditures,
- 5 and (2) allowing the expenditure limit to increase only when there is an
- 6 increase in personal income.

Statement of Purpose:

To redefine the state "spending cap" in order to limit growth on all state spending, including on and off-budget items, and to eliminate inflation as a factor and only tie the spending cap to growth in personal income.
