**AN ACT CONCERNING CIVIL PREPAREDNESS FOR CLIMATE
CHANGE TRENDS, THE USE OF TOWN AID ROAD PROGRAM
FUNDS FOR CLIMATE RESILIENCY AND REVISIONS TO THE STATE
WATER PLAN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the state's civil
- 2 preparedness plan to consider projected climate trends, allow town aid
- 3 road program funds to be used for construction and reconstruction to
- 4 increase resiliency against extreme heat and precipitation and require
- 5 the state water plan to be updated to consider the impact of climate
- 6 change on water quality and the effects of temperature and precipitation
- 7 information when identifying water quantities and include an
- 8 implementation plan for reducing effects from climate change on water
- 9 supplies.

Statement of Purpose:

To better enable towns to undertake climate change-related resiliency
efforts.
