AN ACT CONCERNING THE EMPLOYMENT OF MINORS AT LEAST SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE IN CERTAIN OCCUPATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 31-23 of the general statutes be amended to authorize 2 minors sixteen years of age to be employed or permitted to work in 3 occupations in the hospitality, restaurant or grocery industry that are 4 currently limited to individuals who are eighteen years of age, 5 including, but not limited to, occupations in commercial kitchens and 6 delis, provided such minor receives the appropriate training to operate 7 any equipment and such minor is directly supervised at all times by a 8 person eighteen years of age or older who is trained in the operation of 9 such equipment being operated by such minor.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the scope of work that minors sixteen and seventeen years of age can be employed or permitted to work in.
