***AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADEQUATE PRESCRIPTION OF PAIN
MEDICATION FOR CANCER PATIENTS, PALLIATIVE AND NURSING
HOME PATIENTS AND PATIENTS EXPERIENCING CHRONIC
INTRACTABLE PAIN.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow health care
- 2 practitioners to adequately prescribe medication to manage pain for
- 3 patients with a cancer diagnosis, palliative or nursing home patients and
- 4 patients experiencing chronic intractable pain.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow health care practitioners to adequately prescribe pain medication.
