AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADEQUATE PRESCRIPTION OF PAIN MEDICATION FOR CANCER PATIENTS, PALLIATIVE AND NURSING HOME PATIENTS AND PATIENTS EXPERIENCING CHRONIC INTRACTABLE PAIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow health care
- 2 practitioners to adequately prescribe medication to manage pain for
- 3 patients with a cancer diagnosis, palliative or nursing home patients and
- 4 patients experiencing chronic intractable pain.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow health care practitioners to adequately prescribe pain medication.
