AN ACT REQUIRING PARENTAL NOTIFICATION PRIOR TO THE TERMINATION OF A PREGNANCY BY A MINOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to require that, prior to the termination of a pregnancy by a minor, the parent or guardian of any minor who seeks to terminate such pregnancy is notified, provided such minor may seek and receive court approval to terminate the pregnancy without such notice in a proceeding that ensures the minor's anonymity and is conducted with sufficient expedition to allow her to terminate the pregnancy.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that the best interests of a minor are protected when facing an unplanned pregnancy.
