**AN ACT PROHIBITING HEALTH INSURANCE COMPANIES FROM
UNILATERALLY LIMITING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR
SPECIAL NEEDS CHILDREN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit health insurance
- 2 companies from unilaterally limiting health insurance coverage for
- 3 special needs children, including health insurance coverage for physical
- 4 therapy, occupational therapy, speech pathology and feeding therapy
- 5 services.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit health insurance companies from unilaterally limiting health insurance coverage for special needs children, including health insurance coverage for physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech pathology and feeding therapy services.
