**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDING TO PAY  
CERTAIN SYSTEMS BENEFITS CHARGES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allocate funding received by
- 2 the state under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, P.L. 117-2, as
- 3 amended from time to time, for the purpose of paying systems benefits
- 4 charges accrued by electric distribution companies in connection with
- 5 hardship protection measures during the COVID-19 pandemic.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allocate funding received by the state under the American Rescue Plan Act for the purpose of paying systems benefits charges accrued by electric distribution companies in connection with hardship protection measures during the COVID-19 pandemic.
