## AN ACT REQUIRING TITLE PROTECTION FOR PHYSICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any person from using the title "physician" or any initials associated with such title that represents to the public that such person is authorized to practice medicine or surgery and from advertising services under the description of "physician" unless such person is licensed, registered or otherwise authorized under chapter 370 of the general statutes.

## Statement of Purpose:

To require title protection for physicians.
