AN ACT REQUIRING TITLE PROTECTION FOR PHYSICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any person from
- 2 using the title "physician" or any initials associated with such title that
- 3 represents to the public that such person is authorized to practice
- 4 medicine or surgery and from advertising services under the
- 5 description of "physician" unless such person is licensed, registered or
- 6 otherwise authorized under chapter 370 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To require title protection for physicians.
