AN ACT REQUIRING THE USE OF VEIN ASSIST TECHNOLOGY OR PHLEBOTOMY ASSISTANCE TOOLS FOR PATIENTS WITH COMPLEX VENOUS ACCESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require clinical laboratories,
- 2 blood collection facilities, source plasma donation centers and hospital-
- 3 affiliated laboratories to use vein assist technology or phlebotomy
- 4 assistance tools for patients with complex venous access.

Statement of Purpose:

To enhance the quality of care of patients who are having their blood collected and ensure more equitable access to necessary health care services.
