***AN ACT CONCERNING TUITION WAIVERS FOR DEPENDENT
CHILDREN OF PERMANENTLY DISABLED VETERANS AT PUBLIC
INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to require the Board
- 2 of Regents for Higher Education and the Board of Trustees of The
- 3 University of Connecticut to waive the payment of tuition at the public
- 4 institutions of higher education under each board's governance for any
- 5 dependent child of a veteran who has a service-connected disability
- 6 rating of one hundred per cent, as determined by the United States
- 7 Department of Veterans Affairs.

Statement of Purpose:

To waive the payment of tuition at public institutions of higher
education for the dependent children of veterans who have a service-
connected disability rating of one hundred per cent.
