AN ACT CONCERNING TUITION WAIVERS FOR DEPENDENT CHILDREN OF PERMANENTLY DISABLED VETERANS AT PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to require the Board of Regents for Higher Education and the Board of Trustees of The University of Connecticut to waive the payment of tuition at the public institutions of higher education under each board's governance for any dependent child of a veteran who has a service-connected disability rating of one hundred per cent, as determined by the United States
- 7 Department of Veterans Affairs.

Statement of Purpose:

To waive the payment of tuition at public institutions of higher education for the dependent children of veterans who have a serviceconnected disability rating of one hundred per cent.
