AN ACT REQUIRING FUNDING FOR REGIONAL FIRE TRAINING SCHOOLS THROUGH APPROPRIATIONS IN THE STATE BUDGET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to require sufficient funds be appropriated to the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, from the General Fund, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2025, and June 30, 2026, to fund the nine regional fire training schools, as opposed to providing such funds through any specific taxes or increased surcharges, including, but not limited to, fees on insurance premiums.

Statement of Purpose:

To fund the nine regional fire training schools through appropriations in the state budget and not from any specific taxes or increased surcharges, including any fees on insurance premiums.
