AN ACT CONCERNING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF CHANGING RESIDENTIAL ELECTRIC SUPPLIERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 283 of the general statutes be amended to specify that
- 2 when a residential electric utility customer elects to change electric
- 3 suppliers, such change shall be made effective within one billing cycle
- 4 unless such customer's election was made three or fewer days before the
- 5 end of a billing cycle.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that requested changes in residential electric suppliers be made effective within one billing cycle.
