AN ACT CONCERNING CIVIL ACTIONS FOR DAMAGES RESULTING FROM AN ALLEGED DEPRIVATION OF RIGHTS COMMITTED BY A POLICE OFFICER, USE OF FORCE, AND SEARCHES OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That (1) section 52-57k of the general statutes concerning a cause
- 2 against a police officer for damages be repealed, and (2) the changes
- 3 made in public act 20-1 of the July special session to (A) section 53a-22
- 4 of the general statutes concerning use of force by a peace officer, (B)
- 5 section 54-33b of the general statutes concerning searches of pedestrians,
- 6 and (C) section 54-330 of the general statutes limiting consent searches
- 7 of motor vehicles, be repealed.

Statement of Purpose:

To repeal certain provisions of public act 20-1 of the July special session concerning the conduct and actions of police and public safety.
