AN ACT MAKING THE CONNECTICUT PAID FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE INSURANCE PROGRAM AN OPT-IN PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 31-49e to 31-49t, inclusive, of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to (1) eliminate the requirement in subsection (b) of section 31-
- 3 49g of the general statutes that employees contribute a percentage of
- 4 such employees' subject earnings to the Family and Medical Leave
- 5 Insurance Trust Fund, and (2) make the Paid Family and Medical Leave
- 6 Insurance Program an opt-in program.

Statement of Purpose:

To make the Connecticut Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Program an opt-in program.
