Introduced by: SEN. SAMPSON, 16th Dist.

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT THE ENACTMENT OF NEW OR ENLARGED MUNICIPAL MANDATES BE APPROVED BY A VOTE OF NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS OF EACH CHAMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 2-32b of the general statutes be amended to require any
- 2 bill creating or enlarging a state mandate to local governments be
- 3 approved by a vote of not less than two-thirds of the members of each
- 4 chamber of the General Assembly.

Statement of Purpose:

To require any bill creating or enlarging a municipal mandate to be approved by a vote of not less than two-thirds of the members of each chamber of the General Assembly.
