AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF A FOUR-DAY SCHOOL WEEK AND SCHOOL START TIMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require the 2 Commissioner of Education to conduct a study concerning the benefits 3 and disadvantages of converting to a four-day school week and optimal 4 school start times for students in grades kindergarten to twelve, 5 inclusive.

Statement of Purpose:

To conduct a study to explore the potential advantages of a four-day school week and determine optimal school start times.
