AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SUPERIOR COURT TO ENJOIN THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE'S CERTIFICATION OF CONTESTED STATE LEGISLATIVE ELECTION RESULTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to authorize the Superior Court to enjoin the Secretary of the State from certifying results in an election for state senator or state representative whenever a candidate for such office files a contest of such results, any such injunction issued to remain in effect until the Senate or the House of Representatives, as applicable, resolves such contest in accordance with section 7 of article third of the state Constitution.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize the Superior Court to enjoin the Secretary of the State's certification of contested state legislative election results.
