***AN ACT PROVIDING CIVIL IMMUNITY TO INTERSCHOLASTIC
ATHLETIC ORGANIZATIONS AND THE SANCTIONING BODIES OF
PRIVATE YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS THAT ADOPT GENDER IDENTITY
POLICIES CONCERNING ATHLETIC PARTICIPATION AND
COMPETITION.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to render interscholastic
- 2 athletic organizations and the sanctioning bodies of private youth
- 3 organizations immune from civil liability for adopting any policy
- 4 requiring a participant who has a gender identity that is different from
- 5 the gender listed on the person's official birth certificate to compete on
- 6 a gender-specific sports team that matches the gender on the birth
- 7 certificate.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide civil immunity for interscholastic athletic organizations and
the sanctioning bodies of private youth organizations when such
entities adopt policies that require an athletic participant to compete on
a team that matches the gender identity on the person's birth certificate.
