AN ACT MAKING SURCHARGES IMPOSED ON MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS OPTIONAL AND LIMITING MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 14-49 and 14-49b of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 (1) make any surcharge imposed on the registration of a motor vehicle,
- 3 including the federal Clean Air Act fee and the Passport to the Parks fee,
- 4 optional for the registrant and require such registrant to agree to pay
- 5 any such surcharge, and (2) limit the amount of the fee for the
- 6 registration of a motor vehicle to the actual cost incurred by the
- 7 Department of Motor Vehicles to process such registration.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide savings to the registrants of motor vehicles in Connecticut.
