AN ACT ENCOURAGING LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO REGIONALIZE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- That section 10-285a of the general statutes be amended to (1) reduce
 the reimbursement percentage a town may receive for a school building
- 3 project grant by twenty points if such town (A) has fewer than twenty-
- five thousand residents, (B) is not a member of a regional school district,
- 5 and (C) contains a high school that is under the jurisdiction of the local
- 6 board of education for the town; and (2) increase such reimbursement
- 7 percentage for a town by twenty points for a five-year period following
- 8 such town's establishment of a regional school district.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage the establishment of regional school districts.
