AN ACT ESTABLISHING PFAS-RELATED PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY TESTING STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to require that public water suppliers conduct regular monthly testing to assure that PFAS levels are not greater than twenty parts per trillion and that if the average of such tests over three months shows a level higher than such standard, the supplier shall undertake actions to reduce PFAS through efforts such as linking the supply to new sources of water, installing PFAS filters and blending well waters that have high and low levels of PFAS.

Statement of Purpose:

To create a maximum contaminant level for PFAS in public drinking water supplies.
