AN ACT CONCERNING THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE AND ELECTION RECANVASSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That chapter 148 of the general statutes be amended to require that (1) the Secretary of the State, or a designee, be present at any recanvass conducted for any election for state office, and (2) the office of the Secretary of the State revise the recanvass procedures manual at least once every two years for purposes of standardizing best practices and addressing process deficiencies.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Secretary of the State, or a designee, be present at recanvasses involving elections for state office and to require that the recanvass procedures manual be revised at least once every two years.
