***AN ACT PROHIBITING HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS FROM
REQUIRING PATIENTS TO PROVIDE AN ELECTRONIC PAYMENT
METHOD TO BE KEPT ON FILE WITH THE PROVIDER.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit a health care
- 2 provider from requiring a patient to provide an electronic payment
- 3 method to be kept on file with such provider.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit a health care provider from requiring a patient to provide an electronic payment method to be kept on file with such provider.
